

## InRHA YEAR END AWARDS

1. Exhibitors and owners must be current InRHA members
2. InRHA membership must be paid prior to accumulating points
3. Must show at 50% of shows held in Cloverdale to be eligible to win a year end award
4. All Non-Pro and Youth classes are calculated on one horse one rider basis
5. Open classes are calculated on the horse as long as all riders and owners are members
6. Points for year end awards are calculated as follows:
  - a. 1 point for each horse you beat, up to 20
  - b. Classes must have 3 entries to earn points
  - c. Non member ridden horses are used in point tabulations
  - d. Points for ties are added, then divided by the number of tied horses

EXAMPLE: 25 entries,

First place receives 20 points and is an INRHA member

Second place receives 19 points and is an INRHA member

Third place receives 0 points because they are not a member

Forth place receives 0 points because they are not a member

Fifth place receives 16 points and is an InRHA member

Continued through 20th place (including ties)

EXAMPLE: 5 entries

First place receives 5 points and is an INRHA member

Second place receives 4 points and is an INRHA member

Third place receives 0 points because they are not a member

Forth place receives 2 points and is an InRHA member

Fifth place receives 0 points because they are not a member

7. In case of a tie at year end, it will be calculated as follows
  - a. Highest number of points won at the Summer Fun Reining
  - b. Most number of shows competed in
  - c. Co - Champions
